Course Details

To attend a coaching course, all children MUST be a member of West Bridgford Tennis Club. Membership forms are available online and at reception.

All courses are taken by LTA accredited (+) coaches.

Payment for each course MUST be made prior to the start of the course. Courses book up quickly so fill in your application form, with payment, to guarantee a place.

In the case of inclement weather, NO lessons will be cancelled for juniors or mini tennis. A suitable tennis related activity will be held instead.

Adult sessions may be cancelled in the case of inclement weather. Additional rainy dates are provided on the relevant courses.

Standard Guide for course levels;

Entry - Beginners and players who have little experience on a tennis court.

Club - Players who can keep a rally going over the net from the appropriate baseline. A basic knowledge and understanding of match play and how to score. Ability to serve and use a variety of different strokes.

Master (invitational) - Players who are competent in playing a match and can rally consistently from the baseline with knowledge of spin and tactical awareness. Top club and county players will be invited to the master level.
